Career-based intervention program (CBI)

As a student at Cliff Park High School, you will be participating in a career based intervention program. This includes the following.

- 1) Online Job Readiness Course (worth .5 credit)
 - All students will be required to complete an online job readiness course. This may only be waived if the student has received a career exploration and/or vocational training elsewhere.
 - The students must pass the course with a **70% average** in order to receive a credit.This is the same standard in all of the students' classes.

- 2) Senior Portfolio (worth .5 credit)
 - All students before graduating will complete a senior portfolio that demonstrates they are college and career ready.

- 3) Work Credits (for students working and volunteering)
 - Students who are working will do the following:
 - Tell CBI teacher location of employment
 - Turn in pay check stubs for elective credit and/or proof of employment
 - Tell CBI teacher about any changes in employment
 - Understand that CBI teacher will have evaluations for employers to complete.
 - Understand that the work credits are awarded as followed:
 - 45 hours = .25 credit
 - 90 hours = .50 credit
 - 120 hours = .75 credit
 - 180 hours = 1.00 credit
